## HAMILTON GAULT MEMORIAL FUND

#### **EDUCATIONAL BURSARY TERMS OF REFERENCE** -2021 Version

1. <u>Amount and Number of Bursaries</u>. The number of bursaries per year will be determined by the HGMF Board of Trustees based on recommendations from the HGMF Education Bursary Committee.

2. <u>Eligibility</u>. In order to be eligible for a HGMF Educational Bursary, you must be a serving, former or retired member of the Regiment or their spouse, child or grandchild or a member of a PPCLI Cadet Corps. Applicants for an HGMF Educational Bursary must be enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution.

3. <u>Post-Secondary Institutions</u>. An eligible educational institution is defined as any accredited degree or diploma granting post-secondary institution (i.e. university, community college, or technical school), located anywhere in the world. Distance learning at an accredited institution are eligible for an Educational Bursary.

4. <u>Application Procedure</u>. Applications, at Appendix 1, are available through the HGMF Educational Bursary Coordinator at <u>tim.p@rogers.com</u>. Applications must be received, no later than 15 July, by the HGMF Educational Bursary Coordinator:

5. <u>Obligation</u>. The bursary recipient(s) must enter the post-secondary institution of his/her choice in the year of application and maintain a course of study leading to a diploma or degree. **Part-time, correspondence, or evening courses are not admissible.** It is the obligation of the recipient to maintain satisfactory progress and to submit the Certification Form to the HGMF Educational Bursary Coordinator on completion of the year. A Statement of Understanding must be completed prior to the first semester. (Appendixes 2 and 3 will be sent to those selected for a bursary).

6. <u>Selection</u>. The HGMF Educational Bursary Committee will use the selection criteria, based on the applicants' submission as outlined at Appendix 4 in order to prioritize applicants.

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#### **EDUCATIONAL BURSARY APPLICATION FORM**

The educational bursary program was established to provide financial assistance for the purpose of advancing the post-secondary education of applicants. To be eligible, an applicant must be enrolled with an accredited post-secondary institution. The bursary awards are applicable to post-secondary students enrolled full-time in university, technical school, community college, or any other accredited degree or diploma granting institution anywhere in the world. Distance learning at an accredited institution are eligible for an Educational Bursary.

Applications must be fully completed and received by the HGMF Educational Bursary Coordinator at:

not later than 15 July annually. Applicants must have completed Grade 12 or equivalent prior to being accepted to receive a bursary. In addition to this form, applications must include:

- an official transcript of last academic marks (Grade 12 or previous year post- secondary);
- letter(s) of reference from high school principal/counsellor giving a summary of academic and extra-curricular achievements (as applicable);
- letter(s) of reference from the unit Commanding Officer/PPCLI Association Branch President (if applicable);
- if a cadet, a letter of reference from the Cadet Corps CO giving the applicants accomplishments; and
- any other significant letter(s) of reference as required.

Bursary recipients are required to acknowledge their commitment to successfully completing their year of studies (or face reimbursement of the monies) prior to the year, end. Previous bursary winners wanting continuation of the subsidy must reapply in full each year, in competition with new applicants.

Recipients will receive a bursary in the name of either Hamilton Gault, a past member of the Regiment deserving of recognition or one of the prime financial contributors as decided by the Hamilton Gault Memorial Fund Board of Trustees, whose decision is final.

- 1. The Hamilton Gault Memorial Fund Educational Bursary Committee are to use the following four scoring criteria when determining the priority of HGMF Educational Bursary applicants. The scoring range shall be from a low of one (1) point to a high of five (5) points for each criterion. The applicants with the highest overall scores shall be awarded student bursaries, in priority over the lower scoring applicants.
- The criteria and scoring breakdown are as follows: 2.
  - a) Total Family Income: Parents and students combined income will be scored as follows:
    - (1) Less than \$30K annually 5 points
    - (2) \$30K \$39K annually 4 points
    - (3) \$40K \$49K annually 3 points
    - (4) \$50K \$59K annually 2 points
    - (5) More than \$60K annually 1 point
  - b) Last Academic Marks : From the last year of high or post-secondary school attended:
    - (1) 'A' average or GPA equivalent -5 points
    - (2) 'B+' average or GPA equivalent -4 points
    - (3) 'B' average or GPA equivalent 3 points
    - (4) 'C+' average or GPA equivalent 2 points
    - (5) 'C' average or GPA equivalent -1 point

#### c) Letters of References:

- (1) Leadership potential : 1 5 points
- (2) Community services: 1 5 points\_
- (3) Strong academic effort and desire to succeed: 1 5 points
- (4) Is responsible: 1 5 points \_\_\_\_\_
- (5) Works well with others: 1 5 points
- d) Additional Factors: As determined from the application form
  - (1) Family Situation: 1 5 points \_\_\_\_\_
  - (2) Compassionate circumstances: 1 5 points
  - (3) Accommodation expenses: 1 5 points \_\_\_\_\_
  - (4) Employment status: 1 5 points
  - (5) Education subsidization from other sources: 1 5 points
